The **ADRC** provided 1,686 one-way driver escort rides in 2022, 1,517 of these rides were accessed by the elderly and 169 were provided to a person with a disability. Our volunteer drivers logged a total of 54,896 miles, with over 2,536 hours of services to lowa County residents last year.


SWCAP-LIFT rides Program staff and volunteer drivers provided 6,522 one-way trips for lowa County residents of all ages to get where they needed to go in 2022.


Volunteers, even those who volunteer once in a while, help us to maintain affordable rates for this service. More than 5,700 trips were provided to seniors and folks with a disability and about 1,500 for folks who were not ambulatory. Other riders typically have limited transportation needs. Without our drivers they might have to miss work when their car is in the shop or struggle to find a way home from the hospital. With 7,300 hours of service and almost 156,000 miles driven in 2022, we could not support our grateful clientele in lowa County and help to maintain their independence without our treasured volunteers!

The **SUN Program** volunteers delivered 24,972 meals to homebound seniors in 2022. Volunteers logged 59,136 miles, with over 3,462 hours of services to lowa County residents in 2022.
